## PROJECT Lifesaver Huron

Providing equipment for individuals who may wander or become lost.

Individuals living with Alzheimer, Dementia, Autism, Acquired Brain Injury, Downs syndrome or other cognitive disorders.

These individuals wear a lightweight transmitter which emits a radio signal that can be located up to 2 km away by specially trained OPP officers using mobile locating equipment.

If the person is missing, the caregiver calls 911 immediately.

## PROJECT Lifesaver Huron

- Participants must live in Huron County
- A caregiver lives with them and agrees to test the battery daily and complete the paperwork
- The caregiver agrees to call 911 every time the person goes missing
- All equipment remains the property of Huron County Paramedic Services
- Set up fee \$400 plus \$10/month for battery/wristband changes or a monthly payment plan of \$43.32.
   The set up fee may be waived; please call us to discuss.

Use of this equipment is not a substitute for responsible caregiving, nor does it guarantee a successful outcome if a person is reported missing.
